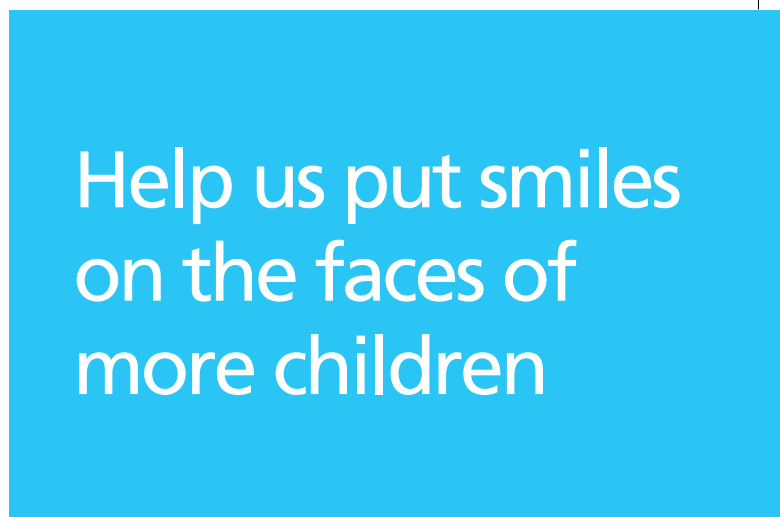

PACT works with families to achieve three key objectives:

- ✓ **To improve the life chances for children, parents and individuals**
- ✓ **To support and counsel parents in the choices they make for children**
- ✓ **To provide a professional adoption, fostering and family support agency in Oxfordshire, Berkshire and Buckinghamshire**

We target homeless teenage parents, victims of domestic violence, families facing child protection issues and ethnic minority families requiring support to integrate into local communities.

We run children’s centres, extended school services, small client-led groups and individual work with families.



PACT also provides NVQ training for workers in the voluntary and statutory care sector.

Patrick’s story

As part of its work as an adoption agency, PACT finds “forever families” for children who haven’t always had the happiest start in life.

Among those children placed with a PACT family was four-year-old Patrick who was unwanted by his alcoholic birth parents.

He spent the first two years of his life strapped in a pushchair, facing the wall. He could hear what was happening around him but the other children were not allowed to speak to him.

Initially, an angry, hurting and very traumatised child, he has come round to seeing the world as a loving, kind place and his new family at the centre of that.

Now aged eight, Patrick welcomed his new adopted sister with this message: “Don’t fight, don’t lie, don’t swear. We can play together.”
