A-Z of Corporate Challenge Ideas

A – Use your £50 in high street charity shops or a car boot sale and sell your purchases via a **Workplace Auction**. Make it a silent or vintage auction to spice things up.

B – Arrange a **Bake Sale**. Why not invest in some culinary décor to make your bake sale event more spectacular? National muffin day takes place on 26th February.

C – Set a date for a **Charity Car Wash** and share with colleagues, friends and family. I The more cars washed and the more people involved the closer you get to the £500 target!

D – **Declutter Donation Drive**. Collect donations from staff members such as toys, clothing or unwanted gifts and sell them to raise funds. Alternatively run a **Digital Fundraising Challenge**; use the initial funds given by PACT to run online fundraising campaigns such as crowdfunding or social media challenges to raise money.

E – Arrange an **E-waste Recycling Drive**: Using the initial investment for petrol money, collect old electronics and e-waste from the community and arrange for responsible disposal or recycling. Raise funds by charging a fee for drop-off or pick-up services.

F – Consider a **Family Fun Day** and how you can invest the £50 in an environment with games, activities, and entertainment for employees and their families.

G – Escape the screen with a **Gaming Session**. Make a shortlist of the best-looking board games and purchase one with the most employee votes. Charge an entry fee and play a tournament over successive lunch breaks.

H – How about a **Hike-a-Thon**? Ask a local design company to produce some maps of local hiking routes. Teams can seek sponsors for every mile hiked on a designated trail.

I – **Island Luau Party**: Host a tropical luau party with Hawaiian music, hula dancing, and island-inspired cuisine. Charge for tickets and offer a prize for the best Hawaiian outfit.

J – Go classic with a **Jellybean Counting Contest**. Fill a jar with jellybeans and have participants guess the number of jellybeans in the jar for a chance to win a prize.

K – Get some fresh air and celebrate **National Kite Flying Day** on February 8th. Invest in a kite which comes with an activity kit to create your own design. Teams or individuals can pay an entry fee to enter a design and whichever design looks best in the air wins a prize.

L – Another classic – host a **Lucky Draw Raffle**.

M – **Merchandise** – Invest £50 in your most talented member of staff to raise funds.

N – February 12th is **National Clean Out Your Computer Day**. Organise a contest where participants submit their stories or photos of their most cluttered desktops.

O – Open up a **One-Day Pop-up Shop**. Featuring unique or donated items, shoppers can purchase goods with profits going towards PACT.

P – Pancake day takes place on February 13th – make a day of it with a range of activities such as a **Pancake Flipping Contest** or a **Pancake Photo Contest** where participants submit their best pancake creations or pancake-themed photos.

Q – Run a classic **Quiz Night Fundraiser** where teams compete in a trivia quiz covering various topics. You can sell refreshments during the event to raise additional funds.

R – Go retro with **National Retro Day** on February 27th. Put the initial sum towards activities such as throwback karaoke, a retro trivia night or a retro clothing day.

S – February 24th is National Tortilla Chip Day. Why not organise a **Salsa-making Contest** where participants pay an entry fee to taste and vote for their favourite salsa. A side competition could be stacking the tallest tortilla chip tower.

T – How about a company **Tuck Shop** open over the course of the challenge?

U – Encourage mindfulness with an **Unplugged Day**. Employees make a donation to take part in a number of activities that encourage team building away from the screen.

V – Encourage staff to consider **Virtual Fundraising** with the initial £50 to be used to help source any resources they may need.

W – Wear Red for **National Wear Red Day** on February 3rd. You could invest in a red-themed quiz night or a bake sale with the colour in mind.

X – **Xbox or Gaming Tournament**. Host a video game tournament. Borrow a console from one of your employees and invest in a popular game. Participants pay an entry fee, and the winner receives a prize or trophy.

Y – **Yoga Equipment Sale**: Collect donations of gently used fitness/yoga mats, blocks, and accessories. Organize a sale of equipment to raise funds for PACT

Z – **Zero Waste Challenge** - Use the £50 towards a green initiative in your office and encourage participants to take place in their own zero-waste challenge where they aim to reduce waste in their daily lives. Participants can seek sponsors for their efforts and raise funds based on their success in reducing waste.
